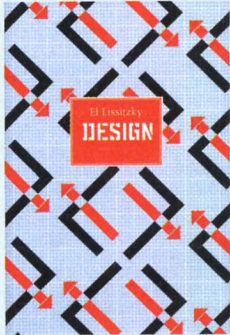

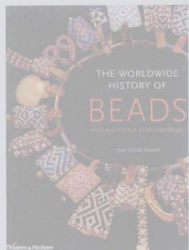
Militaria: Medals.
